Dads 'call in the Army'!

Fathers and their families affected by family breakdown will benefit from a pilot scheme

launching this month in Romford.

The project, a collaborative venture between Christian charity Fathers Outreach and Romford's Salvation Army, will provide free pastoral care and practical support to fathers. Regular events will

include activity sessions for fathers and their children, social gatherings for separated dads, and one-to-

one assistance such as help with attending court, and counselling.

"Fathers separated from their children are a forgotten segment of society, with unique needs" said Tom

Jones, who founded Fathers Outreach last year after suffering the loss of his own son. "We know what

it's like to lose everything that matters, because we've been there – homelessness, poverty and endless

court hearings, on top of separation from the children you love. It's too much to expect anyone to bear

alone.

"This venture will provide specialist, community-based support to people who desperately need"

somewhere to turn to, delivered by knowledgeable, caring and experienced people. We are delighted to

have found a home and partners in Romford and with The Salvation Army, to commence this pioneering

task"

Romford's Salvation Army will partner with Fathers Outreach to provide a home and a range of

specialist facilities for the charity's activities, to complement its existing programme of community

activities.

Commanding Officer Major David Evans, of The Salvation Army, commented "Family breakdown is a leading cause of homelessness, suicide and many other social problems for countless people in our community. This innovative new venture working with fathers complements our existing family programmes, and is in The Salvation Army's best tradition of seeking out and helping those who are marginalised and forgotten by the rest of society."

Fathers Outreach are holding an open evening, to which fathers and their families are invited, at which special guest Lord Roberts of Llandudno will launch the initiative. This will be held on Monday, 27 February at 1930 hrs, at Romford Salvation Army, High Street, Romford RM1 1JJ.
